As a community-centric venue, Treetops Tavern's primary concern during the outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19) is to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our staff, members and guests.

Following the Federal Government's advice on Wednesday 18th March on the restriction of all non-essential gatherings to a maximum of 100 people we have implemented the following measures, these measures are to maintain our duty of care to staff and guests.

1. Treetops Tavern will continue to operate within the current Federal Government's guidelines. Occupancy of the venue will be monitored so as not to exceed 100 people.
2. All persons who have returned from overseas from midnight Monday 16 March, 2020 are required by law to self-isolate for a period of 14 days and as a result will not be permitted to enter.
3. While onsite at our venue staff and patrons are encouraged to practice good personal hygiene. We have placed anti-bacterial soap in our soap dispensers and have sanitizer available.
4. In our dining areas (where possible) we reduced the amount of seating to enable patrons to practice social distancing of the recommended 1.5 metres. Staff have increased sanitation of all spaces, specifically high touch areas.

Persons who do not cooperate will be asked to leave our venue.

We ask for your cooperation and understanding as we continue our commitment to offering a safe venue for all to enjoy. If you have any questions please seek to speak with our General Manager. We will update this policy accordingly with Federal Government advice.
